Super Bowl Party!

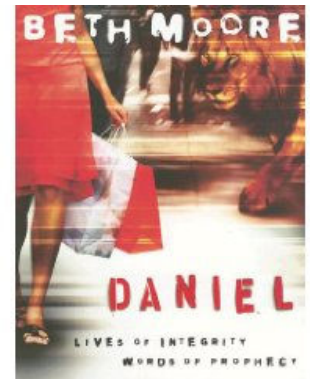
