From Your Shepherds

Dear Church Family,

We are writing to you with great news. A church named the 242 Community Church has approached our leadership about renting space from us a few evenings a week. We have agreed to a three month trial period that allows them to use the building for what they call restore groups on Sunday, Tuesday and Wednesday nights. These small groups are Christians gathering for support, accountability, teaching, and relationship building. Each restore group has it own topic, ranging from financial responsibility to divorce care.

The 242 church has invited our membership to participate with them in these groups. Once we have the details of the groups we will pass the information on to you. We are very hopeful that this opportunity will allow us to build relationships where we can learn from and bless each other.

Also In October when we presented a timeline to the congregation we told you that the timeline was not set in stone and that there was the possibility we might be able to accomplish some of our goals more quickly.
