Tuesday, 2/17 6:30-8:00 pm

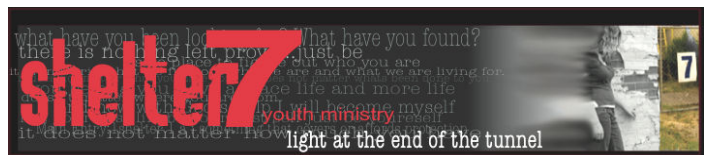
