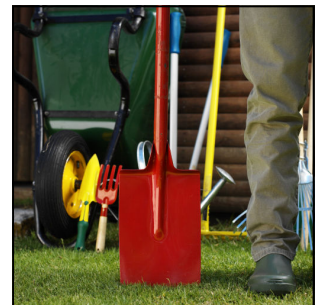


Our monthly Feed the Flock dinner is a great time to get to know each other and enjoy our Christian family in a relaxed setting. **We look forward to seeing you!**

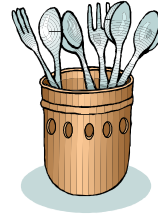
