Our Heavenly Father

What do you think of when you think of a father? Too many fathers, in reality, have not been the perfect father even though they may have wanted to be. So I think of the Heavenly Father. In I John 3:1-3 we read:

"How great is the love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are! The reason the world does not know us is that it did not know him. Dear friends, now we are children of God, and what we will be has not yet been made known. But we know that when he appears, we shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is. Everyone who has this hope in him purifies himself, just as he is pure."

There are some valuable lessons I see in this. The Father is perfect and He thinks of us. Being the children of the perfect One we want to bring honor to Him. We strive to purify ourselves so that we bring credit to our Heavenly Father.

In this world of dysfunctional families, many families don't have their father present. This hurts our image of the word "father". How can we change this image? I believe that we have to think of verses like I Corinthians 11:3 where it says, *"The head of every man is Christ."* We would be the fathers we want to be if we men always let Christ be our head. We would be the true leaders in our family, helping our wife and children always be focused on God. We would *"love our wives the way Christ did the church"* (Ephesians 5:25), thus showing that Christ is our head. We would *"train our children in the instruction of the Lord"* (Ephesians 6:4), thus showing Christ is our head.

If we would only follow God's plan we would be more satisfied and confident with ourselves. This doesn't mean



that we wouldn't make mistakes. But our family would know that our love is real and genuine and that we are seeking their good even when we make mistakes. The best advice one can receive from the Father who lavishes His love on us is to let Christ be our head. Knowing we will do all to please our Heavenly Father, we will be the physical father that all of our children desire and deserve.

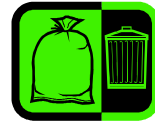
